In the last three years, AZCO's total employee count, including craft and contingent workers, has grown by 82%, and the last year has seen the union construction subsidiary of Burns & McDonnell have its largest revenue year on record.

"While this downtown move was necessary to accommodate our growth, it also demonstrates our commitment to the Appleton community," says Earle Cianchette, AZCO president and CEO. "Though we are a national construction company, we're proud of our Appleton roots, and it is in that spirit that we continue to give back to the local community wherever possible."
